OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

The FCRSC recognizes those dogs and owners who strive to master some of the most difficult aspects of the sport of dogs. The accomplishments that are eligible for the Outstanding Achievement Award are listed below. **To apply for an Outstanding Achievement award, please do the following:**

1. Circle the achievement name(s) below.
2. For each achievement, supply one of the following as substantiating information. **Make sure that the show/trial giving club name and the date of achievement are included on the photocopy. This information will be engraved on the plaque.**
 - A copy of the CKC Certificate indicating the achievement egg. BIS, Field Trial Win, HIT, FTCh, AFTCh
 - A copy of the Dogs in Canada certificate egg. Top 10 in Sporting Group
 - A copy of the Dogs in Canada results where the achievement was published e.g. BIS, Field Trial Win, HIT, FTCh, AFTCh, Qualified All Age Retriever ??
 - A copy of the page in Online magazine or Retriever Field Trial News magazine where the field achievement was published egg. Qualified All Age Retriever, Field Trial Top 10 Retrievers
 - If applying for the Dog World Award in Obedience, supply copies of the pages in Dogs in Canada results showing the score at each of the three trials, or, supply a copy of the actual Dog World award certificate.

ALL ROUND RETRIEVER AWARDS

The All Round Retriever Award recognizes those owners and dogs who compete in three (3) specific disciplines; conformation, obedience and field.

This category consists of 3 levels: All Round Retriever, All Round Retriever Advanced and All Round Retriever Excellent. Titles required for each level are listed below.

To apply for an All Round Retriever award, please do the following:

1. Circle the award level and titles achieved. Enter the date of the third title for engraving on the plaque.
2. Supply one of the following as substantiating information **for each title**: a photocopy of the CKC certificate or, a photocopy of the page in Dogs in Canada magazine where the title was published.

VERSATILITY DOG AWARDS

The Versatility Dog Awards recognize those owners and dogs that compete in three (3) or more disciplines, that may include some, but not all, of the specific areas of conformation, obedience & field.

The disciplines that are recognized in the versatility awards are: Conformation, Obedience, Field (Working Certificate Test or Hunt Test), Tracking, Agility, Flyball or Scent Hurdling, and Drafting.

Note: If your dog has achieved three titles, one in each of conformation, obedience and field, please apply for an All Round Retriever award instead of a Versatility award - see above.

This category consists of 3 levels: Versatility Dog, Versatility Dog Advanced, and Versatility Dog Excellent.

To apply for any Versatility Award, please do the following:

1. Enter the information required by the level of Versatility Award you are applying for (see appropriate section on the next page).
2. Supply one of the following as substantiating information **for each title (or additional title)** that qualifies you for the award(s) you are applying for: a photocopy of the CKC certificate, or, a photocopy of the page in Dogs in Canada magazine where the title was published (or similar "official" notification). ??

Versatility Dog (Level 1)

- a) **For dogs that have not won or do not qualify for an All Round Retriever Award (i.e. do not have titles in conformation, obedience and field):** To qualify for a Versatility Dog Award, the dog must have one title from **three** of the seven disciplines listed below.
- b) **For dogs that have won or qualify for an All Round Retriever Award (i.e. have titles in conformation, obedience and field):** It is possible for one dog to win both an All Round Retriever Award and a Versatility Dog Award. However, a dog cannot qualify for both awards with the same three titles. To qualify for a Versatility Dog Award, the All Round Retriever dog must achieve an additional title from another discipline i.e. must have one title from **four** disciplines: one from each of conformation, obedience and field (for the All Round Retriever Award), **plus** one title from one of the following disciplines: tracking, agility, flyball or scent hurdling, and drafting.
