DIRECTIONS TO AGILITY SITE

Chippewa Park, Specialty Headquarters

FROM THUNDER BAY

Take Hwy.61 South to Chippewa Road (soon after you go over the Kaministiquia River). Turn left on Chippewa Road and go approximately 3.5 km (2 mi) to three way stop. Continue straight, now called City Road, for approximately 4 km (2.5 mi) and keep right toward Chippewa Park. Continue another 2 km (1.2 mi) and turn left into Chippewa Park.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Confirmation of receipt of entry will be emailed (or phoned) to you.
Confirmation of start time and order of classes will be confirmed by email after entries have closed. First trial will not start earlier than noon.

You MAY enter both the tracking test and the agility trials.

Move-ups will be permitted between trials. If a title is earned after closing date, dog may move up providing Trial Secretary is notified by July 18, 2005.

The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding.
There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.

Placement rosettes for first to fourth in each jump height in each class.
All qualifying dogs will be awarded a standard CKC rosette.
Highest Qualifying Flat-coated Retriever in each class, both trials will receive a trophy. All Qualifying Flat-coated Retrievers will receive a trophy/prize.

Highest Qualifying Dalmatian in each class, both trials will receive a trophy.
Highest Qualifying Cavalier in each class, both trials will receive a trophy.

Bitches in season CANNOT compete in the Agility test.
All entry fees will be returned to the owner or agent provided that notice in writing, accompanied with a veterinarian's certificate, is given to the Test Secretary before the start of the test.
