Entry forms must be completed in full and accompanied by Entry and Listing Fees.

A CKC listing fee of \$8.56 (including GST) is payable for each entry of a dog for which a CKC or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. An ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the hunt test or all awards to the dog will be canceled. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Working Certificate Test Rules and Regulations Books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 100 – 89 Skyway Ave., Etobicoke, ON M9W 6R4
2. Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The Pacific Rim Hunting Retriever Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form. No phone faxed, telegraphed or late entries will be accepted.
3. Running order will be determined by draw at the home of the test secretary after time of closing.
4. Make cheques payable to PRHRC. No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
5. A separate entry form for each dog in each test is required (official CKC entry form).
6. Entry fees will not be refunded after June 8th, 2008. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.
7. In the event of a possible mail strike, please courier or hand-deliver to the Test Secretary prior to closing date.
8. Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the grounds.
9. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the tests to qualify for a refund.
10. Pheasants and/or ducks will be used on land and ducks will be used for all water tests.
11. All Throwers, Judges and Competitors should wear dark or camouflage clothing. Handlers shall not wear white or light clothing at any time, but handlers may wear handling jackets for the blinds in the WCX.
12. ERN's (Event Registration Numbers) for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC. ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

13. The Pacific Rim Hunting Retriever Club, its members and the land owners will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
14. Electric collars (either dummy or live) prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds, at any time during the event.
15. There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumpers which are thrown by hand by the handler, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or at anytime during the event.
16. There will be no concession available on the test grounds.

There will be no camping available on the grounds. Accommodations should be arranged prior to arrival. Please check with your motel/campground regarding their policy for accommodating dogs. Book early!!

TEST HEADQUARTERS

Hunt Test Headquarters will be located on the grounds off Swallowfield Rd. and will be well marked with signs.

Directions: If driving from Sidney (Swartz Bay Ferry Terminal), follow Hwy 17 to Victoria. Follow the signs to Hwy #1 North to Nanaimo. Follow Hwy #1 North past Duncan. Turn **RIGHT** at the Crofton/ Salt Spring Island turn off. (Mt Sicker Road) Turn **LEFT** at the T-intersection then **RIGHT** onto Swallowfield Road.

If traveling from Nanaimo (Departure Bay or Duke Point Ferry Terminal) follow Hwy #1 South past Chemainus. Turn **LEFT** at the Crofton/Salt Spring Island turn off (Mt Sicker Road). Turn **LEFT** at the T-intersection then **RIGHT** onto Swallowfield Road. Please check BC ferries for departure times and reservations are recommended. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

On report of the test-giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Hunt Test Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within twenty-one days after the test, report to the Canadian Kennel Club the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of The Canadian Kennel Club shall have the power

to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated. A copy of this rule shall be prominently placed in every premium list.
