This is a special award that will be offered to highlight the dual-purpose nature of the Flat-coated Retriever.

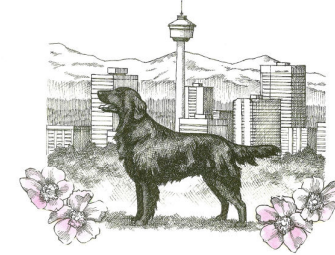
To qualify your dog must show its BEAUTY *and* its BRAINS by:

**ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS:** Personal cheques will be accepted however, **they must be payable for the FULL AMOUNT OF THE ENTRY, payable in US funds. Discounted cheques will not be honoured. Do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds or "at par".** Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

## CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

### REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following CKC classes, divided by sex will be provided.

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards
Open	for all dogs
Veteran 7 to 9	for dogs 7 years of age but under 9 years of age
Veteran 9 to 11	for dogs 9 years of age but under 11 years of age
Veteran 11 plus	for dogs 11 years or older

**NOTE:** Veteran class dogs do not compete for winners, but shall compete for Best of Breed.

Dogs competing in veteran classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only for dogs that are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained Championship status. The entry of a 'listed' dog is not allowed.

### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed or neutered. Points MAY NOT be carried from regular competition judging to the Altered Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed in the regular classes.

**Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female.**

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes; the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners, and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

**SECTION 15.1.1** A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

**SECTION 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

**SECTIONS 15.1.3 TO 15.1.7** (summary) To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**SECTION 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

**SECTION 15.1.9** A dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.

**SECTION 15.1.11** A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

CHAPTER 19.7 of the Conformation Show Rules state: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

### Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination

### EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN, AT THE LATEST, MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. ## NON-REGULAR AND UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Dogs must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only  
Exhibition Only dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-regular classes

**NOTE:** Puppies 3 to 6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any Regular, Non-Regular or Unofficial Classes.

Stud Dog & Get Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brace Two dogs of the same breed, not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead

Field Retriever Has a CKC WCX, one SH leg, MH title or a CKC sanctioned field trial placement. Class divided by sex.

Working Retriever Has a CKC WC, WCI or JH title. Class divided by sex.

*Note: Dogs entered in Non-Regular and Unofficial Classes may be spayed or neutered.*

## OBEDIENCE / RALLY CLASSIFICATIONS

### REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Pre-Novice for dogs that have not earned the title of PCD (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada, and have not earned a CD in Canada or elsewhere.. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice class.

Novice A for dogs that have not earned the title of CD (Companion Dog) in Canada or any other country Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises.

Novice B for dogs who have not earned the title of CD in Canada. For trainers, multiple entries, or dogs who have earned titles in another country. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person and more than one dog may be entered.

Novice C for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher in Canada. Scores earned from this class are not eligible for High in Trial.

Novice Intermediate for dogs that have earned the title of CD or higher in Canada. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner. The CDI (Companion Dog Intermediate) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Open class. Scores earned from this class are not eligible for High in Trial.

Open A for dogs who have earned the title CD in Canada, but have not earned the title of CDX (Companion Dog Excellent).. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, that person must handle the dog in all exercises. No professional trainer or person who has obtained a UD title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Open B for dogs who have earned the title CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. More than one dog may be entered in this class by any one person or owner.

Utility for dogs who have earned the title CDX in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person however that person must handle the dog in all exercises.

## UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

- Brace open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a CD title in Canada. The same person need not own both dogs. The exercises shall be performed as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Brace Class may be entered in any regular class or for Exhibition Only

- Rally Novice A dogs may not have a RN title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.
- Rally Novice B any dog until a qualifying score is earned in the Advanced class.
- Rally Advanced A dogs that have a RN title but not RA title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.
- Rally Advanced B dogs that have a RN title. May continue to compete after earning RA title.
- Rally Excellent A dogs that have RA title but not RE title or any CKC Obedience title. Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.
- Rally Excellent B dogs that have a RA title. May continue to compete after earning RE title
