DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

FROM CALGARY:

Head north on Deerfoot Trail (QE II or Hwy 2) to Exit 275 (Hwy 566). Turn east (right) at Exit 275 (Hwy 566) and head towards Kathryn for approximately 17 kilometres. The grounds are located on the north (left) side of the road. Watch for signs. For a map to the location please see link at www.flatcoat.ca.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Running order will be pre-selected by draw. A running list will be available at the tests.

Each dog may only be entered in ONE of the WC, WCI or WCX tests. A dog must have a CKC WC title before entering the WCI test, and have achieved a WCI title before running the WCX test.

The WC test and the WCI/X test will run concurrently. If you have multiple dogs entered, please inform the marshals and the running order will be adjusted to accommodate you.

Confirmation of receipt of entry will be sent via e-mail.

Meet at 7:30 AM, dogs to line 8:00 AM

Check in with marshal at test site on arrival.

Ducks will be used for water stakes and ducks or pheasants will be used for land stakes. All handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a standard CKC rosette and a trophy and/or prize. Bitches in season MAY compete in the WC tests but they will be run last.

Lunches must be pre-ordered. The cost is \$15.00 CDN and includes a sandwich, a piece of fruit, a drink and a sweet. Lunches will be available for pickup at the test site. Please use the Official CKC Entry Form to order.

The Golden Retriever Club of Alberta will be holding a Working Certificate test at the same grounds on Monday, August 2, 2010. Their Test Secretary is Pat Mitchell and will be at the grounds on Sunday, August 1, 2010 to take move up forms. Their premium list will be available at www.canuckdogs.com. Don't Miss the FCRSC Annual Scurry!!

The Annual Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada Scurry returns!!
Enter your working dog, your puppy or your faithful old couch potato.
This fun event is open to everyone.

A Scurry is a timed, straight forward, single retrieve of a plastic bumper. Maximum distance will be approximately 80 yards. The timer starts as the dog Crosses a line just in front of the handler and stops as he/she crosses back with the bumper. Dogs may be held on line, released at will and encouraged to work with as much yelling, jumping up and down and hat throwing as possible.

This is a wonderful opportunity to introduce the joys of retrieving to uninitiated dogs. Lots of encouragement from the handler - and the gallery, if so desired - will make the novice dog believe he/she is participating in the most exciting event imaginable. Or enter your seasoned retriever just to prove he/she is the quickest thing on four legs! (Side bets allowed!!)

Prizes will be awarded to the Fastest FCR, Fastest Overall Retriever, Fastest Puppy, Fastest Veteran (7+ years), oldest Retriever, as well as fun prizes for a variety of categories.

Entries are just \$2.00 each or 3 retrieves for \$5.00 and
you may enter as many times as you wish.
No pre-entry required - all entries taken the day of the Scurry.

Chapter 14.7 of the WC Test Rules state: It is the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations is not subject to any indignities. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
